



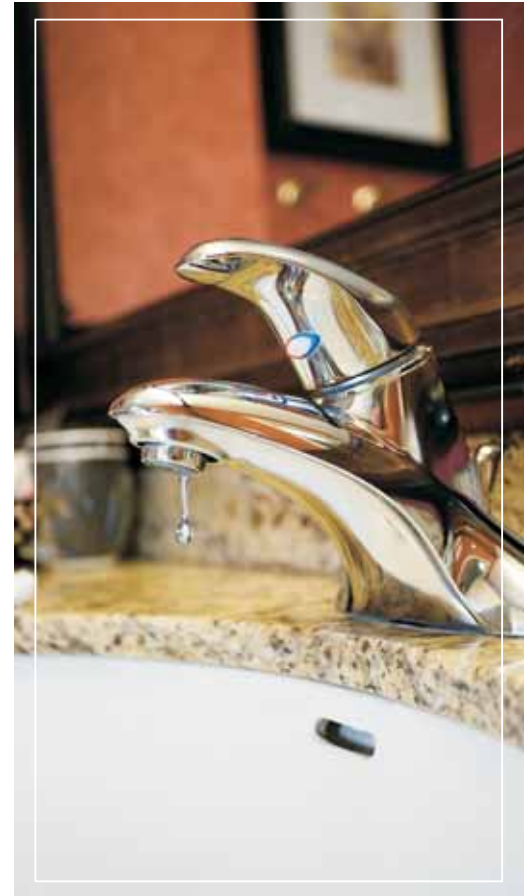
SAVE THE PLANET AND SAVE A BUCK

WATER CONSERVATION

- Fix a leak
- Take shorter showers
- Wash cloths with a full wash load
- Run your dishwasher full, scrap dishes before washing
- Sweep instead of using a hose
- Don't let water run while brushing or shaving
- Use less paper napkins, Switch to cloth ones at home
- Reduce sprinkler times and only water at the cool times of the day
- Make sure sprinklers water the lawn, not the street and driveway
- Keep cold water in the fridge instead of running it to get cold
- Replace shower and faucet heads with water efficient ones
- Buy a tank-less water heater



ECO FACTS:

- *The typical American home uses about 300 gallons of water a day.*
- *A 1/32" leak in a faucet can waste up to 6,000 gallons of water a month, or 72,000 gallons a year.*
